

INTERSECTING OBJECTS

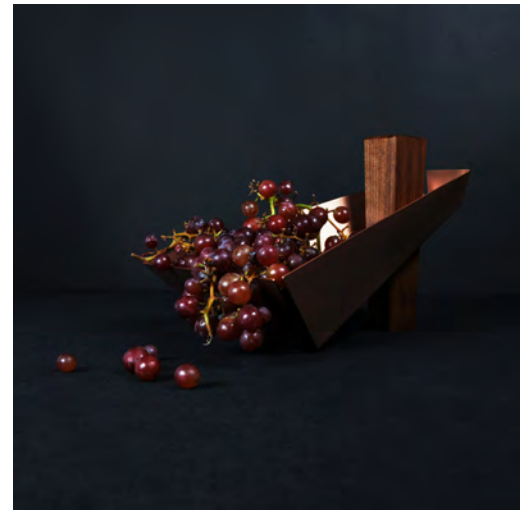
Pedestal Trays
