Project Safari - an alluring collection of five ceramic animal bust-forms. Each form is styled through an in-depth exploration of the features and personality of their respective animal. The intention is to capture the essence of each animal by breaking out and distilling their unique features into compelling geometric renditions. The final shapes are delivered through a considered approach to achieve a unified collection of compelling subjects. Ceramic Stoneware was chosen as the material for Project Safari because it is precious - fragile yet resilient. This choice represents an appropriate reflection of the real-world counterparts in the wild; they are cherished - endangered yet tenacious. They are creatures of the earth that should be valued and protected.

The bust-forms are made in stoneware and offered in a white or charcoal glaze. The collection was designed by Bronsen in Brooklyn, NY and each piece is handmade in America.
