Lori Katz works as a studio artist in the Washington DC area. Her current body of work involves the controlled inlay of contrasting stoneware clay bodies and the exploration of surface texture and color.

Lori Katz's wall squares are available in three standard sizes: small-5", medium-10", large-12". Groupings are limited in size only by the size of the site wall, allowing for installations of limitless dimension. Each wall square is backed on wood and wired to hang simply from a picture hook. The squares are easily adapted to work with hanging security. A hanging template can be provided for all groupings.

Lori Katz's wall pieces are well suited to residential or corporate settings and are included in many collections including those of Amazon Web Services, the IBM Company, the US Embassy in Bandar Seri Begawan, New York Presbyterian Hospital and many private homes.

Lori is a maker, drawn in by the challenges inherent in her materials. Her pieces stand alone or as integral parts of a greater whole.
