

## Invictus Steelworks introduces The Wave Table at the 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Architectural Digest Design Show

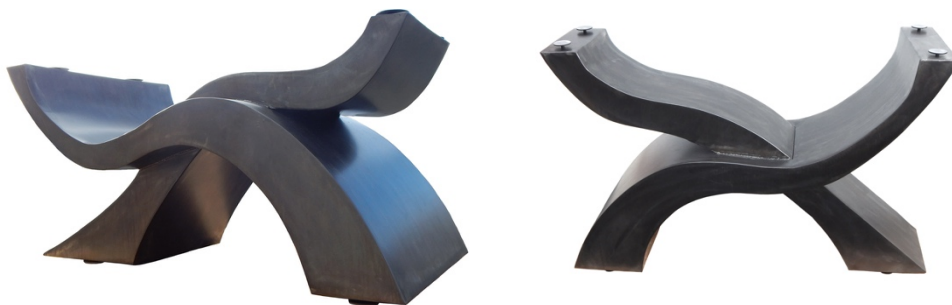
*“The Wave” was inspired by the Artist’s years as a crab fisherman on the Bering Sea*

**FARR WEST, UTAH – March 8, 2017** – Invictus Steelworks, makers of luxury handmade custom steel furniture, gazebos and sculpture, will be debuting The Wave at the 17<sup>th</sup> annual Architectural Digest Design Show in New York City, March 22-25, 2018. The Wave is a new addition to the company’s designer “Camber Collection”. In addition to The Wave, Invictus Steelworks will be featuring several other original table designs, as well as original sculpture at the show.

Furniture designer Robert Simmons, along with his wife, Beth, founded Invictus Steelworks in 2015. For a number of years, Robert worked as a crab fisherman on the Bering Sea, and Simmons drew from his experiences on the turbulent Alaskan waters for inspiration when designing The Wave.

“Once you were on the open sea, the view was singular. There was nothing but endless walls of foamy gray water crashing all around, one after the next. The waves were 30’ or more, towering over our vessel, bouncing us from crest to trough and back up again. There is nothing quite like seeing a wall of water looming over you. The sea likes to remind everyone that she’s in charge. In her fury, she is powerful and strong, yet at the same time, she’s beautiful,” Simmons says about his time at sea.

It was the Bering Sea and her beautiful fury that Simmons brought to life as functional art. But Simmons prefers to call this particular design a steel sculpture that sits under a glass top. The design features two waves passing through each other, momentarily becoming one, before curling away from each other towards the sky.



Shown in a steel gray patina, this work of art makes the dance of the waves seem almost elegant, as if time had softened Simmons’ memories of the turbulent waters, made them somehow gentler. The Wave is but a glimpse into a moment in the life of the artist. If you

stand back and use your imagination, you too can see the waves rolling past and dipping down, before making their massive water wall ascent back to the top.

All of Invictus Steelworks' designs are made to order and fully customizable. The Wave is available in almost any dimension, from coffee table to conference table, and there are over 100 finishes to choose from. Finishes include a host of architectural paints, polished steel, brushed steel with a satin lacquer for a stainless steel look and feel, and various patinas. Glass levelers are included for fine leveling adjustments on the top, and felt covered adjustable leveling feet protect your floor while allowing leveling on any surface.
