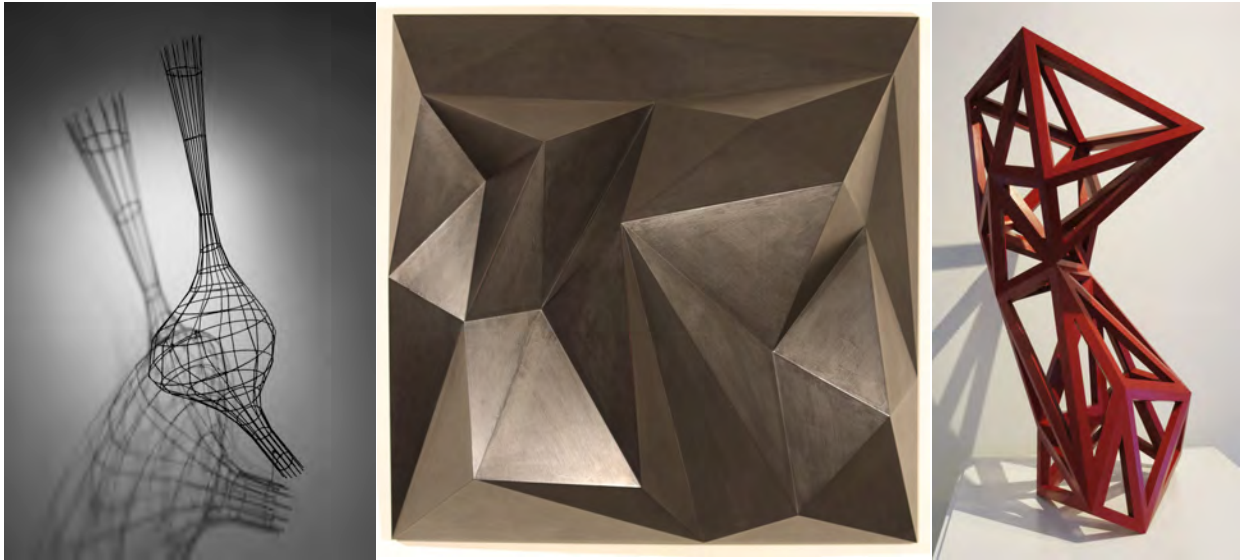

ABOUT JOSHUA ENCK

Joshua Enck creates lyrical yet succinct forms that surprise viewers with complex geometries and jaunty stances. His animated abstractions capture the tension between the spontaneity of the imagination and the restraint of meticulous craftsmanship. Drawing on his training in architecture and furniture design, Joshua employs labor-intensive metal fabrication and woodworking techniques to bring intuitive, complex forms to life. He continually experiments with materials and techniques to express new possibilities, creating an eclectic oeuvre united by engagement with formal abstraction. He is the recipient of a Fulbright-Nehru Academic and Professional Excellence Fellowship for studying traditional metalwork in India and a Windgate ITE International Residency for wood art in Philadelphia.
